





OUR SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK

Today's Gospel: John 20:19-31



How does one come to belief? This is a contemporary question every bit as much as it was for the early church. The Thomas-story within the "Pentecost" story (with the disciples locked in a room out of fear, then Jesus defying locked doors, and breathing the Holy Spirit into them) is encouraging for all who struggle with an inability to hope and trust. Rather than condemning Thomas for his lack of faith, Jesus simply offers Thomas what he needs: "touch my wounds and see for yourself."

How has the risen Jesus broken through your locked doors?

Share a "Thomas" moment. How have you found your way out of doubts?

Thomas leads others to the wounds of Christ, where is Christ's body wounded in our world?

Divine Mercy Sunday is April 7. In the year 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized Saint Maria Faustina Kowolska and added the Feast of Divine Mercy to the Church's official calendar. Saint Faustina, who died in 1938, was a member of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Krakow, Poland. She came from a poor family of farmers, had only three years of schooling, and performed the humblest of tasks in her convent. But she also was a mystic who was privileged to have many private revelations from our Lord, including a vision of Jesus wearing a white garment with beams of red and white coming from His heart, which came to be known as the image of Divine Mercy.

Divine Mercy Sunday focuses on the gift of mercy and love given through Christ's death, burial, and resurrection. As Pope John Paul II stated, "Divine Mercy reaches human beings through the heart of Christ crucified."

Divine Mercy Sunday is an opportunity for plenary indulgence. The usual conditions are as follows: sacramental confession [according to previously issued norms, within about 20 days before or after] Eucharistic communion [according to previously issued norms, preferably on the day, or the days before or after].

Prayers on Divine Mercy Sunday at St. Ambrose Parish will begin at 2:45 pm. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed at 3:00 pm. There will NOT be Confessions or Adoration at this time so please note the times for Confession on the St. Ambrose page in this bulletin. Please feel free to stay for Mass at 4:00 pm.

Have you seen the movie CABRINI? When Italian immigrant Francesca Cabrini steps foot in America in 1889, she is greeted by disease, crime, and impoverished children living in New York's slums. Armed with a fearless spirit and a compassionate heart, Cabrini sets off on a daring mission to convince the hostile mayor to secure housing and healthcare for society's most vulnerable. Despite broken English and poor health, Cabrini leverages her entrepreneurial mind to build an empire of hope unlike anything the world had ever seen.

Canonized a saint in 1946, she is the first U.S. citizen to be named a saint. She founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a religious institute that was a major support to her fellow Italian immigrants to the United States. This moving and inspirational movie is playing at the Movie Mill in Lethbridge and is a must-see, as reported by many of our parishioners.
