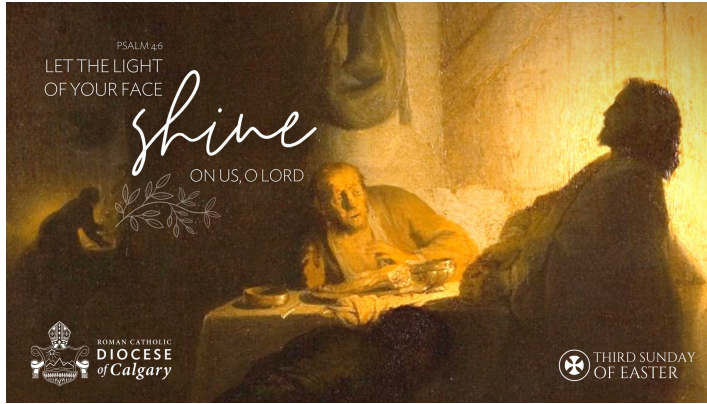

Bill C-7 - Canada's Catholic bishops have issued a forceful condemnation of the country's new assisted suicide law, saying the possible pressures it will place on Canadians with mental illness or disabilities are "all too real, perilous, and potentially destructive."
