

May is Mary's Month – St. Catherine's CWL encourages everyone to pray the rosary at home during May. Mary is advocate, helper, benefactress and mediatrix: intermediary through which the Son of God entered this world to save us from sin, through her faith she aided in reconciling sinners to her Son, and, because of her assumption and role as mother for all of us, she prays for us, interceding on our behalf just as she did at Cana, asking the Lord to bestow graces to us as He wills. **New restrictions announced May 4** by Premier Kenney mean that only <u>15 people are allowed in places of</u> <u>worship</u>. Including Father Ian, a sacristan, a lector and a registration person, we will only be allowed 11 other parishioners in the church. There will be no ushers, music ministry or projectionists. These 11 people will be allowed in on a first-come-first serve basis. Once a total of 15 people is reached the church doors will be locked.

There are a few things that can be done to help our parishes during these latest restrictions:

1. <u>Please consider only attending 1 mass per</u> <u>week.</u> There will still be Mass Tuesday evening, Wednesday morning and 3 Sunday Masses. Attending weekday Mass fulfills your Sunday obligation and helps leave room for other parishioners.

2. <u>Please consider watching a live-streamed Mass</u>. See the information and link in this bulletin.

3. <u>The parish offices will be closed beginning on</u> <u>Monday May 10</u> until it is safe to reopen them. You can still reach the office by phone during regular working hours.

4. Fr. lan will be on retreat the week of May 17 – 21 so there will be no Mass on May 18 or 19 or Adoration on May 21. Please be mindful of this on the weekends of May 16 and 23. Also, please keep Fr. lan in your prayers.

5. <u>Please pray for our parishes during this difficult</u> <u>time.</u> We must stay united as a church family and support each other in staying safe and well.
