OUR SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK



Using symbolic language, John the Evangelist describes who John the Baptist is and what his mission will be. In every gospel John the Baptist plays an important part but always he is subordinate to Christ. John the Baptist is the one to prepare the way of the Lord, but he is not the Lord. Undoubtedly there were some at that time who thought John the Baptist was the messiah. But John the Baptist knew who he was.

John the Baptist is very certain of his own identity. Do we know who we are? How did John the Baptist prepare the way for Jesus?

How is John the Baptist a model for us?

We can never take the light for granted. It needs to be tended carefully. In what ways can we be joyful witnesses to the light during this Advent season?

Did you see the 2023 Christmas stamp from Canada Post? This Vancouver artist Adrian Horvath's latest work holds special importance for him as a Christian. His design for the 2023 Christmas stamp, Madonna and Child, portrays the new-born Jesus cradled in Mary's arm as she gently gazes down with love.

"I have had the honour of doing a few stamps for Canada Post in the past, Horvath said in an email to The B.C. Catholic. "This one was definitely a special one for me."

Horvath described the concept of Mary that he was trying to convey in the Christmas stamp. "I see Mary as someone who was born into a selfless calling and was entrusted with a responsibility beyond herself. 
