Scripture Reflection

If last Sunday's discourse contained practical instructions, this Sunday's passage focuses on the inner attitudes required of those who are sent out in mission of the Good News. The threefold reference to fear indicates that there certainly was fear among the disciples that this whole divine adventure would be for naught, that worldly powers would kill it before it had a chance to flourish. However, once fear has been conquered, courageous witnessing follows, and Jesus himself will intercede before God for all disciples in all time and place.

When are you afraid to proclaim your faith in Jesus? What are the most consoling messages in today's Gospel for you? What part of the reading do you find most difficult?

St. Ambrose Parish Pastoral Council is in <u>immediate</u> <u>need</u> of a volunteer Recording Secretary. PPC meets the 4th Wednesday of each month, except July and August, at 7:00 pm at St. Ambrose Church lobby. Meetings last 1 – 1.5 hours.

Duties:

a) 7 – 10 days before the meeting, put out call for reports from committees and ministries, compile reports, send out reports to PPC members before meeting. Put meeting reminder in bulletin for the weekend before meeting.
b) Day of meeting attend PPC meeting and take minutes.
c) Type the minutes up ASAP after the meeting so don't forget details. Submit typed minutes to parish office for filing. Submit notices from PPC for bulletin to parish office. Send DRAFT minutes to PPC members.

c) Maintain regular contact with PPC Chairperson in case of changes, etc.

a) able to take accurate, unbiased minutes (training available); excellent listening skills


b) use of computer programs, preferably Microsoft Word; able to use email and send documents
