Dear Parishioners,

As you have heard Masses opened up beginning June 1st, it is a good sign of things to come! Our respective councils scheduled a couple masses in each parish as a trial run and the council members graciously volunteered so these celebrations could happen:

St. Ambrose Parish - Tuesday evening, June 2 at 7:00 pm and on Sunday June 7 at 9:00 am.

St. Catherine Parish - Wednesday morning, June 3 at 9:00 am and on Sunday June 7 at 11:00 am.

On Sunday morning after mass, Fr. Ian will meet with the councils at both parishes to determine the on-going mass schedules.

Please be advised future masses will depend on Volunteers to help out and keep this endeavor going. Note: those who are 65 years and older cannot volunteer as they are regarded as Highly Vulnerable. If you are able to volunteer for Sign-In or Usher, please phone the parish office 403-345-3400.

At this time we may allow only 50 people, and only 45 when you take into account volunteers needed to facilitate the re-opening (volunteers by the way and their families are guaranteed a seat). I realize many are still fearful and the Bishop has continued the Dispensation from Sunday Masses.

We have decided to do a first-come first-serve basis and the doors will be locked at 7 pm and 9 am sharp, so come early to sign in. Physical distancing will be practiced and you must wear a face mask and use the hand sanitizer on entering the church building and again on exiting the building.

With the guidance of the Holy Spirit and our willingness to serve Christ as his body, we can make this happen. Be safe and may God's grace and blessing be with you all.


