

Pope's Prayer Intention for September 2020 - We pray that the planet's resources will not be plundered, but shared in a just and respectful manner.

Pontifical Holy Land Collection - This collection in support of the Holy Land, usually collected on Good Friday was cancelled when churches were closed due to the pandemic. Pope Francis has requested that it be taken up on Sunday the September 13 - a date close to that of the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross. This feast celebrates Christ's saving work and also reminds us of faithful Christian pilgrims, like St. Helen when she found the relics of the Holy Cross in the 4th century, who have committed themselves to preserving the holy sites as places of worship that sustain our Christian culture and history of salvation. Let us give generously to the support of Christian communities, the upkeep of the Holy Sites, and the formation of future priests. There will be two baskets in the foyer one for regular collection and one for the Holy Land.
